## NOTICE OF ZONING COMMISSION HEARING TO CONSIDER PROPOSED URBAN AGRICULTURE OVERLAY DISTRICT IN THE GREATER MATTAPAN NEIGHBORHOOD DISTRICT

In concert with the Mayor's Office, and as part of an ongoing effort to increase access to affordable, fresh food in Boston, the Boston Zoning Commission will hold a public hearing on a proposed text and map amendment to establish the Urban Agriculture Overlay District (UAOD) in the Greater Mattapan Neighborhood District. The proposed Overlay District would essentially allow:

- The cultivation of fruits and vegetables, and,
- Composting of materials produced on site.

Under this proposal, the Urban Agriculture Overlay District would be applied to two properties, including:

- 23-29 Tucket Street, Dorchester; and,
- 131 Glenway Street, Dorchester

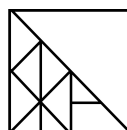
